## **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION**

- 1. High school graduate or candidate for March 2020 graduation (including japanese language school)
- 2. High school graduate or equivalent, has a high academic ability and received 12 years of formal education in a foreign country. Moreover, an applicant with 10 or 11 years of secondary education must be 18 years old and has completed a preparatory education curriculum in a designated institution.
- 3. For International students who satisfy any of the following conditions (1) to (4):
  - (1) passed the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N2 level or higher;
  - (2) scored 200 points and above in the Examination for Japanese University Admission (EJU), and 400 points and above in Business Japanese Proficiency Test (BJT);
  - (3) completed more than a year or at least six months of Japanese language education course recognized by the Japanese Language Education Promotion Association and was notified by the Ministry of Justice; or
  - (4) received more than one year of formal education in elementary school, junior high school or senior high school in Japan.

#### **ADMISSION PROCESS**

1. ADMISSION ON RECOMMENDATION X a person who satisfies the requirements of the single school application

#### (1) DESIGNATED SCHOOL RECOMMENDATION (a person who scores an average of 3.2 and above)

A recommendation letter from your high school or Japanese language school is required. By June, recommendation request form and application form will be sent to your school. During application, please submit the specified application form. For more details, please contact your high school or Japanese language school.

#### (2) RECOMMENDATION FROM SCHOOL

- Candidate for March 2020 high school or Japanese language school graduation
- A person who scores an average of 3.0 and above, and was recommended by the school principal.
- For international Japanese language students, an above average score is required.

#### (3) SELF-RECOMMENDATION

- High school graduate or candidate for March 2020 graduation
- A person who scores an average of 2.7 and above with a strong interest and enthusiasm in welfare / nursing care and choosing it as a future profession.

#### (4) MEMBER OF THE SOCIETY RECOMMENDATION

- High school graduate
- A person with a strong interest and enthusiasm in welfare / nursing care and choosing it as a future profession
- 2. GENERAL ADMISSION ※ A person who is not applicable for the admission on recommendation

- has a desire to learn and aspire on becoming a competitive certified care worker; and
- has a good moral character.

PREPARATION OF APPLICATION FORM AND SUBMISSION

 When the application is approved, prepare the necessary documents and submit.

NOTIFICATION FOR ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

• A notification for eligible applicants will be sent within a week via postal mail after submission of documents.

- (1) Screening results will be sent to you via mail within a week from the day of the examination. We do not accept telephone inquiries regarding the result of examination.
- (2) Please follow the guidelines written in the notification of payment enclosed during application.

  Successful applicants are requested to pay the tuition fee within 10 days after release of notification of result.
- (3) If the payment of tuition fee is confirmed, admission approval letter is sent out via postal mail.
- (4) Approved applicants will proceed to the 2<sup>nd</sup> step of admission procedure and will be notified regarding the date of school entrance ceremony (end of February).
- \* Failure to complete the admission procedure on the specified date is considered no intention for admission.
